Our challenge: This little house had been neglected over the years, and we found dry rot and structural issues. We worked closely with a structural engineer and replaced nearly 85% of the foundation.



Hardwood floors, high-end appliances, granite countertops, insulation and dual-pane windows helped make this a charming, energy-efficient home.

Structural Upgrade for Oakland's Madrone Hotel

A fire in early 2016 was the catalyst for structural and seismic upgrades for this low-income hotel in downtown Oakland. Working closely with the engineers and client on this project, we demolished and replaced the beams and poured new concrete bases for the foundation's eroded column bases.



Structural and seismic repairs, new flooring, electrical and ADA enhancements were part of this project

Our challenge: Removing the subfloor, we found dry rot and termite damage, requiring replacement of the contaminated materials.



Opening up the subfloor revealed dry rot and termite damage

We also upgraded the bathroom to meet ADA standards and built an ADA ramp in the entranceway.

The results: With the structural restoration, the Madrone Hotel can continue its important role of providing a home for low-income residents in the heart of downtown Oakland, close to Chinatown, shopping and transportation.
